




## iDepos—Reporting Solutions



iDepos is a court reporting industry first. Transcripts can be viewed from ALL devices, without ANY special viewers required. If your client has an internet browser, then they can use iDepos. Translate, you can change from English to another language for witness review with a click of the mouse.

iDepos gives the attorney/paralegals control over the presentation and functionality of the transcript including:

- Bolding
- Line numbers and timestamps can be turned on and off
- Font colors
- Page numbers can be included in copy/paste text

Multiple download options include the pdf-it portfolio, zipped folder, and specific file(s).



## Summer Recipe—All-American Burger

### Ingredients

- 1½ pounds 85 percent lean ground chuck
- 1 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 8 strips cooked bacon, chopped fine
- 4 teaspoons yellow mustard
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- ½ teaspoon table salt
- ½ teaspoon ground black pepper

Break beef into small pieces in medium bowl. Add cheese, bacon, mustard, Worcestershire sauce, salt, and pepper. Using fork, toss until evenly distributed. Divide mixture into 4 equal portions and lightly pack into 1-inch-thick patties.

When coals are ready and grate is hot, dip wad of paper towels in vegetable oil and use tongs to rub oil over grate. Grill burgers over very hot fire, without pressing down on them, until well seared on both sides and cooked through, 8 to 12 minutes. Transfer to plate, tent with foil, and let rest 5 minutes. Serve.

## Favorite Hymn—America, My Country, 'Tis of Thee

Samuel Frances Smith graduated from Andover the same year he wrote "My Country, 'Tis of Thee." He was going through a stack of German children's songs given to him by a friend on February 2, 1832. One song caught his eye and he read it and found that it was patriotic. He thought of his own great land and began to pen the words:

Our father's God to Thee,  
Author of liberty, to Thee we sing;  
Long may our land be bright,  
With Freedom's holy light;  
Protect us by Thy might, Great God our King.

Within half an hour, he had written the song My Country, 'Tis of Thee. It has become our favorite American hymn of patriotism.
